Forward Tipping Dumpers - Assessment Only Forward

The Finer Details

This assessment course has been developed to evaluate your knowledge and skills in safely operating a forward tipping dumper.

The course duration will vary depending on the number of learners being assessed, ranging from half a day to one day.

The assessment consists of:

- A multiple-choice question paper
- A practical evaluation of machine operation

The assessment will cover the following areas:

- Plant Safety and the Law
- Machine Knowledge and Preparation for Work
- Traveling and Maneuvering the Machine
- Safe Machine Operation
- Securing Loads and Safe Transportation

Upon successful completion and meeting the required standards, you will be awarded a Certificate of Competence and a Lantra Skills ID Card for the selected certification option.

Who Should Attend?

This course is designed for individuals who are currently operating a forward tipping dumper. It will assess your ability to safely and efficiently operate the machine.

The practical nature of this course requires a minimum level of fitness. If you have any concerns, please contact the provider to discuss your needs.

What Will Be Covered?

At the end of this assessment, you will be able to:

- Understand and comply with health, safety, and environmental legislation
- Interpret and follow work-related documents such as drawings, specifications, schedules, risk assessments, and manufacturers' owner's manuals (MOMs)
- Identify hazards associated with plant or machinery operations and implement control measures
- Recognize and explain machine components and operator controls
- Perform operational and pre-start checks
- Prepare the forward tipping dumper for site and highway travel
- Safely drive the dumper across various terrains
- Operate the dumper safely in restricted spaces
- Transport materials following given work instructions
- Safely place spoil on different terrains
- Shut down and secure plant or machinery
- Understand the procedures for loading and unloading forward tipping dumpers when transported on a trailer
